



## 2016 Visual Art Classes

### *Imagine - Create -Discover*

#### I Love To Draw - Level 1

##### Course Description

Prerequisite: No art experience needed

Student ages 6 to 18 (first through twelfth grade)

This FUN **four** day introductory graphite pencil drawing class provides *take home resources*, learning in a *relaxed environment* paced to meet the individual artist abilities and learning style. The course will focus on:

- building your artist's confidence creating ART and drawing what they see.
- technical skills such as; contour drawing, texture, structure, value, tone, and shading will be reviewed using various graphite pencils.
- students will create a personal portfolio of take away projects including daily drawings and a final *still life* masterpiece.
- students will learn the skill of giving and receiving successful critiques that emphasize trust and encouragement.
- Cost per student \$125.00 includes *artist quality drawing tools* , materials and handouts.

#### I Love To Draw - Level 2

##### Course Description

Prerequisite: I Love to Draw Level 1

Student ages 6 to 18 (first through twelfth grade)

This **four** day pencil drawing class - level 2 reinforces the skills and concepts taught in the pre-requisite course *I Love to Draw - level 1*. The course is packed full of learning and hands on activities including:

- pre-determined daily contour drawing activities that develop your students ability to draw what they see.
- learning a dynamic way of drawing and ability to focus on a segment of work by using a framing technique.
- exploring further technical skills such as; perspective, scale, background, foreground, texture, value, and shading using various graphite pencils and tools.
- creating a personal portfolio of take away projects including daily drawings and a final masterpiece.
- Cost per student \$115.00 bring supplies from level 1 *additional artist quality drawing tools and materials*.

#### Mixed Media Mania

##### Course Description

Prerequisite: No art experience needed

Student ages 6 to 18 (first through twelfth grade)

Do you enjoy making art with various materials and mediums? This **four** day class is for you! Students are exposed to quality art materials, fine art techniques and art history. Students explore creativity and artistry through the use of paper, expressive line, texture, *reuse* materials, various paint mediums, and so much more. Unique projects daily, *take home resources*, fun learning in a relaxed environment paced to meet the individual artist abilities and learning style, inventive ways for creating art focusing on;

- developing art-making skills and techniques,
- learning about and applying elements and principles of design,
- experimenting with mediums to connect their own intuitive art making expression,
- creating a personal portfolio of take away projects,
- Cost per student \$100.00 includes supplies and materials.

#### Meet the Masters

##### Course Description

Prerequisite: No art experience needed

Student ages 6 to 18 (first through twelfth grade)

This **four** day class will *introduce* students to various masters, discuss styles of art, and techniques used. These sessions are packed full of *multi-media* learning, music, exploring various mediums / materials, and *unique* projects to help students pursue art in a genre yet explore their own style. Each class students will explore *an art period / movement* such as;

- Realism, Impressionism / Post Impressionism, Fauvism, Abstract Expressionism, Post Modern & Contemporary, Pop Art, Art Nouveau, Folk Art,
- study a specific artist,
- create a project based on their own interpretation.
- Cost per student \$100.00 includes supplies and materials.

#### Inside Out - Self Portrait

##### Course Description

Prerequisite: No art experience needed

Student ages fifth to twelfth grade

This **four** day class will invite students to explore *Self* through *portraits*. Students will practice drawing, collage, mixed media, and journaling. These sessions are packed full of *multi-media* learning, music, exploring various mediums, and styles. Students will be introduced to various master "*self portraits*", art history, create *unique* take away projects, and explore their own style. Students will investigate self portraits through various lessons including;

- Creating a narrative drawing,
- Using their imagination combined with mixed media,
- Journaling their art making process,
- Learning techniques for mapping their face.
- Exploring various styles to create a self portrait
- Cost per student \$100.00 includes supplies and materials.

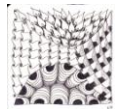
#### Zentangle® - Introduction

##### Course Description

Prerequisite: No art experience needed

*"The Zentangle Method is an easy to learn, fun and relaxing way to create beautiful images by drawing structured patterns with pen and ink."*



Zentangle is a form of artistic practice through a very specific method of deliberate intention that produces **non-objective** drawings composed of patterns (tangles) that can be viewed from all four sides. The act of creating the Zentangle is just as important as the final outcome, which is appreciated for its unique beauty. Zentangle provides benefits of improved focus, creativity, along with an increased sense of well being.

The creativity options and pattern combinations are boundless **and anyone can do it!**
